That judgement ruled that the Minister exceeded his powers in prescribing the 2017 Regulations. The Public Procurement Bill is being finalized, which will empower the Minister of Finance to set preferential procurement, the 2022 Regulations repeal the 2017 Regulations and take effect on the 16 January 2023”

2. Projector Fitting (Network Enabled)

- Install and connect one ceiling-mounted projector with network
- Secure mounting to ceiling with appropriate fittings.
- Run a network cable from the nearest switch to the projector location.
- Test and ensure projector is accessible over the network.

3. Network Point Repairs

- Inspect and repair damaged network points in each office.
- Replace faceplates, keystone jacks, and patch cables as needed.
- Ensure all network points are tested.
- Update documentation for all repaired points.

4. Network Cabinet Cleaning and Labelling

- Physically clean and dust the interior and exterior of the network cabinets.
- Reorganize patch cables for optimal cable management.
- Label all:
 - Patch panels
 - Switches
 - Power sources (UPS, POE)
 - Cables connected to switches and panels
- Provide before and after photos for verification.
